ROSA e.V. Jena

ROSA e.V. is a non-profit association that has set itself the goal of thinking about humanitarian aid in a gender-sensitive way and providing safe spaces for women* fleeing their homes. Women* experience gender-related burdens, such as femicide, forced marriage or genital mutilation, which can force them to flee. These women* are not offered consistent protection on current escape routes. ROSA offers women* a mobile contact point to explicitly provide a protected space for their circumstances and burdens. This service is supported by childcare and medical care. The local group in Jena was formed in summer 2023 and has really taken off since fall 2023. Work is underway to establish the first Safer Space in Thuringia to create spaces for joint design and protection in cooperation with the refugee women* in the respective shelters.



FAIRY Jena

FAIRY stands for feminist antifascist intersectional radical youth. We are a group consisting of pupils, trainees, students, and freelancers in and from Jena who stand up against fascism and sexism.

Trans*solidarische Vernetzung Jena (Trans*solidarity networking Jena)

We are the Trans*solidarische Vernetzung. We are a queer group, i.e. we fight for all those people who do not fit into the social norm, for example because they are lesbian, gay, trans or inter.
